



## INVITATION TO APPLY FOR ELIGIBILITY AND TO BID

The **BUREAU OF PLANT INDUSTRY**, through its Bids and Awards Committee (BAC), invites contractors registered with and classified by the Philippine Contractors Association Board (PCAB) to apply for eligibility and if found eligible, to bid for the hereunder contract:

- NAME OF THE PROJECT : Repair of the National Pesticide Analytical Laboratory (NPAL) Building in Quezon City
- LOCATION : Bureau of Plant Industry, Nursery Compound, Visayas Avenue, Diliman, Quezon City
- BRIEF DESCRIPTION : To supply labor and materials for the repair of NPAL Building located at Visayas Avenue, Quezon City

### SCOPE OF WORK:

1. Repair of roof and ceiling.
2. Repair of Main Lobby/Exhibition Hall.
3. Supply and installation of one (1) set of 6.2 m x 3.4 m accordion type steel grill door and two (2) sets of 0.8 m x 2.4 m swing type steel grill door in the Bodega.
4. Completion of the repair in ninety calendar days.
5. Cleaning/clearing of construction debris and obstruction within the repair site.

Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) : **Php 1,341,429.47**

Contract Duration : 90 calendar days

Prospective bidders should possess a valid PCAB License applicable to the contract, have completed a similar contract with a value of at least 50% of the ABC, and have key personnel and equipment (listed in the Eligibility Forms) available for the prosecution of the contract. The BAC will use non-discretionary "pass/fail" criteria in the Eligibility Check/Screening as well as the Preliminary Examination of Bids. The BAC will conduct post-qualification of the lowest calculated bid.

All particulars relative to Eligibility Statement and Screening, Bids Security, Performance Security, Pre-Bidding Conference, Evaluation of Bids, Post-Qualification and Award of Contract shall be governed by the pertinent provisions of R.A. 9184 and its Implementing Rules and Regulation (IRR).

The BAC will issue Eligibility Forms to the prospective bidders at the BAC Office located at the Crop Protection Division Building, BPI Compound, 692 San Andres, Malate, Manila, upon their submission of LOI to the BPI-BAC. Prospective bidders shall submit the Eligibility Requirements to the BAC at the said address. They may also obtain the results of the Eligibility Check by the BAC at the same address.

The BAC will issue Bidding Documents only to bidders declared by the BAC to be eligible for the bidding upon payment of a non-refundable amount of **FIVE THOUSAND PESOS ONLY (Php5,000.00)** to the BPI-BAC.

The **Bureau of Plant Industry** assumes no responsibility whatsoever to compensate or indemnify bidders for any expenses incurred in the preparation of their bids.
